What is **your response** to God's love—  
the forgiveness of **your sins**?

In Luke's gospel we have a contrast of two people who are very different in their response to the presence of Jesus. Simon, the Pharisee has invited Jesus as guest to a banquet. Apparently he did not provide Jesus with the customary etiquette of the day. Simon thought a lot of himself (self-centered) as a God fearing Jew who judged rightly. He proved this by answering Jesus question correctly. Then you have a harlot who recognizes Jesus not only as a prophet but more than a prophet and is able to see herself through the eyes of God. She pours herself out through her tears in response to the forgiveness she has received. The true grace of God has been received by the woman and it has changed her life. The Pharisee has judged the parable correctly but he has failed to judge the woman and his invited guest. Thus his response to Jesus is based on his conceived righteousness rather than his sinfulness. The love you show to others or the self-centeredness you have, is your response to your invited guest.
